Overview

This project which commenced early works in 2008 and is due for completion in 2010, comprises the expansion of the existing Brisbane Convention & Exhibition Centre to provide:

- An increased floor area of approximately 24,000 m² bringing the total area to 171,650 m²
- An additional 42% in event space
- Two state-of-the-art tiered auditoriums designed specifically for smaller events
- A new ballroom with an extensive outdoor terrace
- An additional 18 meeting rooms
- A large function room on Level 5 with terrace, city and river views
- The introduction of rainwater harvesting through the incorporation of underground tanks with a storage capacity of 3 mega litres

The expanded centre, over five levels, will include 42 meeting rooms, two ballrooms, three Speakers' Presentation Centres, three stand alone Plenary Halls, Four executive boardrooms, ground floor restaurant and retail areas and 20,000 m² of dedicated exhibition space.
